ASK ALL:

DEBATEMIN Imagine that you are moderating a national debate between Donald Trump and Hillary Clinton and you had to decide how much time to give to the following issues. If you had 100 minutes, how many minutes, if any, do you think the candidates should spend talking about their plans on... **[RANDOMIZE ITEMS]**

[INSTRUCTION: Please enter whole numbers. Enter 0 for any issue that you think should not be discussed] *[programming note: include box that dynamically sums allocated minutes; do not allow entries that add to more than 100. Allow respondents to move to next screen if total adds to less than 100. Is it possible to add a soft prompt if minutes add to under 75 that reads: "You have not used all 100 minutes, if you would like to do so, please edit your responses. Otherwise click Next."]*
