PEW RESEARCH CENTER ELECTION QUESTIONS

This is the sequence of questions used to identify likely voters and determine their vote choice in <u>Pew's</u> <u>final pre-election poll</u> in 2008.

Questions in RED are used to develop the likely voter scale. Respondents must say they are certain that they are registered to vote (or intend to register or vote, in states with same-day registration or no registration) in order to be included in the likely voter estimate. Those who say they have already voted (early voting or absentee) are considered likely voters.

Questions in **BLUE** measure candidate preference.

Questions in GREEN are used to identify so called "swing voters."

ASK ALL:

THOUGHT How much thought have you given to the coming presidential election . . . Quite a lot or only a little?

ASK ALL:

- Q.1 How closely have you been following news about candidates for the 2008 presidential election ... very closely, fairly closely, not too closely, or not at all closely?
 - 1 Very closely
 - 2 Fairly closely
 - 3 Not too closely
 - 4 Not at all closely
 - 9 Don't know/Refused (VOL.)

RESPONDENTS IN NORTH DAKOTA SHOULD BE COUNTED AS REGISTERED VOTERS AND SKIPPED TO PRECINCT. DO NOT ASK REGIST OR REGICERT OF THESE RESPONDENTS.

REGIST These days, many people are so busy they can't find time to register to vote, or move around so often they don't get a chance to re-register. Are you NOW registered to vote in your precinct or election district or haven't you been able to register so far?

- 1 Yes, registered IF "DAY OF" STATE GO TO PRECINCT; ELSE GO TO REGICERT

IF RESPONDENT ANSWERED '1' YES IN REGIST AND NOT IN "DAY OF" STATE ASK:
